Share Insurance Protects Your Savings

Good old "Plan B." It's nice to have something to fall back on when things don't go the way you plan. But when it comes to building a financial cushion for retirement, or saving for college or a down payment for a new house, setbacks can be costly. Safeguarding your hard-earned money is critical. That's why Long Island State Employees Federal Credit Union has federal share insurance, administered by an independent government agency, the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA). The National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund (NCUSIF) protects aggregate savings up to at least \$100,000 in your regular share savings, money market, share draft/checking and certificates. The coverage for individual retirement accounts (IRAs) and Keoghs is \$250,000. So how do you know we're federally insured? All federally insured credit unions--like yours--must post the official NCUA insurance sign in their offices.

As do other NCUSIF-insured credit unions, we abide by high standards of safety and soundness. Because of that, NCUSIF is a strong, well-capitalized fund. So bring your savings to us.

You can count on the Long Island State Employees Federal Credit Union to protect your savings.

Funds in traditional IRAs and Roth IRAs are added together and insured in the aggregate to \$250,000. A Keogh account is insured separately up to \$250,000 as well.

Something else about share insurance: It separately Insures individual and joint accounts. For example, say you have an individual account containing \$100,000, and a joint account with your spouse containing \$100,000. Each account is insured separately for a total coverage of \$200,000.

Your savings federally insured to at feast \$100,000 and backed by the full faith and credit of the United States Government **NOCULA** National Credit Union Administration, a U.S. Government Agency

Vacancies and/or re-elections will be filled by election of candidates submitted by the Nominating Committee, which is chosen by the Board of Directors. Nominations may also be made by petition which must be signed by 1% of the membership (25 members). Each nominee, by petition, shall submit to the credit union Secretary, a statement of qualifications and biographical data with the petition. The period for receiving nominations by petition shall be accompanied by a signed certificate from the nominee stating that he/she is agreeable to the nomination, and will serve if elected to office. There will be NO nominations from the floor and no proxy or absentee voting. Three people are up for re-election for the Board of Directors. One person is up for re-election for the Credit Committee.
